You are responsible for:

- Your BC Adaptive Snowsports membership, which can be obtained at www.bcadaptive.com for \$53 (price for 2017-18 season). *Join once your participation has been confirmed.*
- Your four-day lift pass, which will be 50% of the price charged to the public when you present your BC Adaptive Snowsports membership card at the Mount Washington kiosk.
- At our pizza meet-'n-greet and gala banquet, you will pay \$10 per person in your party at the pizza meet-'n-greet and \$25 per person in your party at the gala banquet, which represents our cost for the catering. Children under 12 yrs of age at December 31, 2018 eat for free.
- Accommodation in Courtenay if you are from out of town. The Best Western is the festival lodge this year, offering rooms at a discount for this event.
- Suitable clothing for Snowsports activities and winter conditions.
- If financial hardship would prevent you from attending the festival, some assistance is available, please contact Brian for further information.
- If you are 15 years of age or younger on January 1, 2019, you must attend with a parent or their designate in order to attend the **2019 WINTER SNOWSPORTS FESTIVAL**.
- Do you want to go tubing for an hour on Wednesday afternoon? If yes, then you are responsible for the cost of the tubing pass.
